maintain a positive attitude towards my child's education: read all communication in good time.	celebrate your child's success with you through reports, meetings, awards and rewards!	follow our BIRDS values at all times (in and out of school!).
attend meetings to discuss my child's learning and progress,	provide 3 parent/carers evenings a year alongside additional meetings when needed.	try my hardest in all lessons – understand that things are hard at first but with practise, get easier!
